


Sawmill Parkway Extension

Project Background

Sawmill Parkway is a arterial roadway extending from the City of Delaware south through all of Delaware County and continuing south beyong Interstate 270 to Henderson Road in Columbus. Previous phases of Sawmill Parkway were constructed over a number of years up to US42 and Innovation Court in the City in 2017. In 2022, the City extended the roadway an additional 1,400' to Founders Court in conjunction with an industrial/commercial development in the area. The extension of Sawmill Parkway to South Section Line Road is a long time component of the city and county's thoroughfare plans.

Improvements

In 2023 through 2024, the City will construct the final phase of Sawmill Parkway, known as Phase G2. This phase will extend the roadway 3,200' to a new roundabout at South Section Line Road. The project will also include water and sanitary sewer extensions as well as multi use path along the length of the road.

Schedule & Status

The engineering design is complete and the project is moving to the construction phase. Construction is scheduled to be completed in summer of 2024.
