

Sponsor a Rain Barrel!





Since 2014, the City of Delaware has organized the Olentangy River Festival (formerly the NOW Festival) that highlights our local water resources. The festival includes water activities, raffle prizes, education booths from various environmental organizations, food vendors, live music, and more. This summer, the 11th Annual Olentangy River Festival will take place on June 8th at Mingo Park (500 E. Lincoln Ave. Delaware, OH) from 12 p.m. - 4 p.m. As part of the festival, the annual rain barrel raffle will occur.

Rain barrels provide many stormwater benefits including:

- Reduction of stormwater runoff
- A free and sustainable source of water for gardening
- Reduction of harmful pollutants being carried into our waterways
- Reduction of ponding and flooding
- Reduction of water bill costs



Rain barrels have become increasingly popular. As a community, we can increase this popularity by making them more visually appealing. Businesses, organizations, and individuals have the opportunity to sponsor a rain barrel for \$30. The cost includes the installation kit, sanding, washing, and priming each barrel before it is distributed for painting. The barrels can be both sponsored and painted by the same entity, or a request can be made for a local art class or artist to paint it. The barrels will be raffled off at the River Fest on June 8th at Mingo Park, and proceeds will go to the Olentangy Watershed Alliance (OWA), a non-profit group dedicated to enhancing and preserving the Upper Olentangy River Watershed.



There are a limited number of barrels available for this opportunity. Once that limit has been obtained or the deadline for ordering has been reached, the barrels will be distributed to painters. Rain barrels will be available for pick up or delivery starting Monday April 15th, as requests are received.

If you are painting the barrel yourself, please use outdoor acrylic paint (same paint that is bought for painting the outside of houses, outdoor fencing, etc.). The rain barrels will need to be decorated and returned by May 20th. Once decorated, you can put them on display at your home or business leading up to the River Fest, or arrangements can be made for the barrel(s) to be picked up or dropped off at the wastewater treatment plant facility for the City to put them on display.

All painted barrels will need to be at the City of Delaware's Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility (225 Cherry St., Delaware, OH) before 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 20th.

Please consider participating in this fun event! Raffle ticket sales will begin at River Fest at 12 p.m. and end at approximately 3:30 p.m. with the winning tickets to be drawn shortly after.

- Friday, May 20th, 2024: Painted rain barrels must be completed (notify the Watershed Coordinator when finished so she can pick up or arrange a time for you to return yours to her)
- Saturday, June 8th, 2024: Olentangy River Festival and rain barrel raffle!
